ESP PD Program 課程簡章

壹、課程目的及說明

因應全球化趨勢，行政院頒布了 2030 雙語政策，積極推動高等教育雙語化。因此，教育部於 111 年起委託國立成功大學外語中心成立「大學雙語教師專業發展中心」(EMI Professional Development Center, EMI PD Center)，開設 36 小時複合式線上 EMI 專業發展課程，並於 113 年增設 ESP 專業發展課程，課程主要聚焦於下列四大主題：「ESP-EMI 雙向協作架構」、「ESAP 概念架構」、「ESP 課程規劃」及「ESP 有效教學策略」，並透過「課程規劃實作、分享及回饋」深化 ESP 教師之專業知能。透過課程以及與 EMI 教師共備，引導 ESP 教師精準規劃與執行對接 EMI 課程的 ESP 課程，為學生在日後 EMI 課堂中做更好的語言準備。

本中心將於 115 年下半年開設一場次針對科學 (Science) 領域¹之 ESP 複合式線上專業發展課程，敬邀符合規定及有意願發展 ESP 教學知能的教師踴躍報名參加。

ESP PD Program Description

I. Course objectives

In response to globalization, the Executive Yuan has implemented the Bilingual 2030 Policy, which promotes bilingual education in Taiwan. Since 2022, the Ministry of Education has designated the Foreign Language Center of National Cheng Kung University to establish the “EMI Professional Development Center” (EMI PD Center). This center offers a 36-hour blended online professional development program for university teachers focusing on English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI).

Starting in 2024, the English for Specific Purposes (ESP) Professional Development (PD) program was launched, concentrating on four major themes: “ESP-EMI Collaboration,” “ESAP Conceptual Framework,” “ESP Curriculum Design,” and “ESP Effective Teaching Strategies.” This program will provide participants with opportunities to enhance their ESP competencies and skills through curriculum design presentations, feedback sessions, and reflective practices. By fostering collaboration between ESP and EMI, ESP teachers will be better equipped to design and implement courses that effectively prepare students for learning in EMI environments.

The EMI PD Center will offer a 36-hour blended online ESP professional development program for the Science cohort (S3)¹ in the second half of 2026. University teachers who meet the specified criteria and wish to enhance their ESP teaching skills are encouraged to register.

¹: This cohort is designed for faculty members from the Colleges of Science, Life Sciences, Engineering, Medicine and Nursing, as well as related academic disciplines.

II. Information regarding the registration

A. Target participants (Applicants must meet one of the following eligibility criteria.)

1. University or college full-time English teachers nationwide.
2. EMI teachers who have received the certificate of completion from the EMI PD Center.

*Each class will enroll 20 participants, with an upper limit of 25.

III. Course Information

A. Fee: Free of charge.

B. Course schedule:

The course consists of 5 days' online instruction (30 hours total), with 6 hours of instruction per day (9:00-12:00; 13:00-16:00). Each participant also needs to complete an additional 6 hours of "ESP individual curriculum design presentation, feedback, and reflection." The 6 hours include 4 hours of asynchronous individual tasks (i.e., individual curriculum design and peer feedback) and 2 hours of synchronous lecturer feedback and discussion.

C. Venue: Online courses via Cisco Webex (Participants need to prepare computers, headphones, microphones, and cameras.)

*Note 1: Connecting through cell phones is **NOT** suggested.

*Note 2: Participants are required to keep their cameras on throughout the classes.

IV. Certificate Issuance

A. Certificates will be issued collectively upon completion of the entire program.

- The program consists of a total of 36 hours, made up of 30 hours of online instruction and 6 hours of ESP individual curriculum design presentations, feedback, and discussion
- Participants must complete **a minimum of 33 hours of participation**, which includes 2 hours of synchronous lecturer feedback and discussion.

B. Participants are required to sign in and out each day. If you need to be absent, please fill out the leave application form.

- The total hours of leave should NOT exceed 3 hours.** Leave requests will not be accepted for the following sessions: the first day (course overview), the fifth day (group presentation), and the 2 hours of synchronous lecturer feedback and discussion.
